**Fee Payments** We accept cash, cheque, eftpos and credit card payments at the service or you can process your account using our new Bpay facility which is displayed on your statement.

**Late Fee** An initial fee, plus \$1.00 per minute/ per child after 6pm. These fees are in addition to the daily fee listed on this programme. (This does not attract CCB or any other Government Rebates)

**Cancellation** **After Thursday 29 March 2018, all booked days will incur an \$18.00 per day per child cancellation fee regardless of circumstances**
