I wish to enrol my child to audition for the Creative Music Ensemble commencing in Term 1, 2020. This programme will offer the opportunity to **write and perform songs in a solo, small group and ensemble format**. The class will be a mix of analysis, study and practical application. There will be study of various techniques and tools for song writing such as harmony, melody and structure, as well as creative and listening exercises to develop freedom and expression on your instrument. The course is open for all instruments, singers and electronic musicians. Students need to be at least Grade Three AMEB level of performance, or have been involved with music for several years. The course is designed to lead to a performance of original works. This is an ideal situation for students that have a creative spark and a genuine interest in making music. It also assists with skill development for students in Year 9–12 classroom music.

- There are no tuition fees connected with this programme.
- Lessons will be held before school on Wednesdays from 7.25 – 8.25am.
- The programme is open to students Years 9 – 12.
- There will be a **minimum of 5 students and a maximum of 15 students**

- Students are expected to bring their instruments.
- Students will be provided hand outs of material where relevant.
- Students are expected to work with other students to create group situations for performance.
