Afternoon Tea	Provided by the service unless specified on programme.
Cost	Permanent booking - \$63.00* per day Casual booking - \$65.00* per day <i>*Price per day is inclusive of incursion costs</i>
Child Care Subsidy	If you wish to claim Child Care Subsidy, please register via Centrelink in your MyGov login. You will need to confirm your child's enrolment at the OSHC Service before the Subsidy can be applied to your fees. Please note if you have not attended OSHC for more than eight weeks you will need to confirm your child's enrolment again through MyGov.
Fee Payments	Bpay is our preferred method of payment. Bpay details are displayed on your weekly statement. We also accept eftpos and credit card payments at the service. Statements are emailed out on Mondays for the previous week's attendances.
Late Fee	An initial fee, then \$1.00 per minute/ per child after 6pm. These fees are in addition to the daily fee listed on this programme. (This does not attract CCB or any other Government Rebates)
Cancellation	<u>After Friday 21 June 2019, all booked days will incur an \$18.00 per day per child cancellation fee regardless of circumstances</u>
