Dear Parents and Guardians

From the beginning of this year the College has been investigating the move to progressive reporting. We commenced with our Year 10 students and are now well placed to introduce feedback via progressive reporting for the assessment items completed in Semester Two, for all Junior Secondary students. The only exception to this is Chinese, where reporting will continue in the normal way.

The goal of progressive reporting is for students and their parents to get feedback on each assessment piece, in a timely manner, rather than waiting for the end of semester report. You and your child will receive specific information as soon as the marking has been completed for each piece of assessment. Please refer to your child's Term 3 assessment planner for the due dates of all assessment items.

You will still receive an interim and end of semester report, showing the results for each criteria, for all progressive reporting subjects. As specific feedback about each assessment item will have already been given, there is no need for an additional subject comment in these semester reports.

Results for the assessment tasks can be accessed under Student Details/Curricular Activities, which is the same location through which you had access to the RaVE results and comments last year. Students will have access to this feedback via TrackOne at the same time.
